

On March 12th, the Toronto Medical Officer of Health Dr. Eileen de Villa stated that returning travellers should avoid "group interactions and public gatherings wherever possible."

Based on their recommendations and our own sense of public responsibility we have regrettably cancelled the Achilles St. Patrick's Day Race on Sunday, March 15th.

As this situation has rapidly evolved, we trust you will understand our difficult decision.

Due to this rare and unique situation there will be no refunds.

On the bright side all participants can still drop-by the CNIB Foundation office at 1525 Yonge Street starting tomorrow Friday from 12 noon hour to 6 pm or Saturday from 10 am to 1 pm to pick-up race shirt, swag, and medal. We trust you will complete your own virtual run distance to officially earn your medal.

We are also working on other possible locations for shirt and medal pickup. Locations are still to be determined. We will not be mailing shirts and medals due to the high cost of mailing.
